

Student Representative Council Composition and Terms of Reference

Reporting

The Student Representative Council (SRC) is part of the UniSC Student Governance Framework and reports to the UniSC Student Senate.

Composition

Representatives (Voting Members)

- Two student Co-Chairpersons elected from SRC student representatives
- Student members elected to their respective School Student Groups (SSG)
 - Two School of Health representatives
 - Two School of Business and Creative Industries representatives
 - Two School of Education and Tertiary Access representatives
 - Two School of Law and Society representatives
 - Two School of Nursing, Midwifery and Paramedicine representatives
 - Two School of Science, Technology and Engineering representatives

The co-chairpersons will represent the SRC on the UniSC Student Senate.

In attendance

- Pro Vice-Chancellor (Students)
- Student representatives from relevant UniSC executive committees or working groups
- Student Services and Engagement Secretarial Support

Observers

- Any person with the approval of the Co-Chairpersons.

Terms of Reference

The role of the SRC is to:

- represent the student community and act as a means of communication between Sunshine Coast campus, the University and the student community
- lead activities that foster a sense of belonging and positive student experience in the Sunshine Coast community and promote initiatives that relate to student wellbeing
- provide input into the development of policies and services that support students and advance the quality of learning and research activities
- inform the Student Senate, Student Liason Groups at each campus, and Pro Vice Chancellor (Students) about emerging issues for students within its terms of reference

The role of all student representatives is to:

- actively contribute to University decision making in promoting a positive student experience
- encourage student feedback and share University initiatives resulting from student feedback
- report back to the university and the wider student cohort

Tenure and Frequency of Meetings

There will be at least four meetings of the SRC each calendar year.

A quorum for any meeting of the SRC will be one-half of the voting members.
